We often speak of the YMCA's health benefits and programs, but its true essence lies in the connections forged within. Recently, we spoke with a member of fifteen years, whose experience highlights the enduring power of community.

"If you were to ask me to describe the YMCA in one word, it would have to be friendship," he shared. Since joining in 2010, the Y became more than a place to be for Jarvis, evolving into a hub for meaningful relationships. He participated in community initiatives, but the human element truly captured his loyalty.

His personal journey includes a 90-pound weight loss, supported by YMCA professionals like Elizabeth, whose guidance extended beyond fitness to nutrition. "I've been doing exactly what she taught me for a long time," he noted, highlighting the lasting impact of Y support.

However, his story is fundamentally about friendship. "I've had a group of friends here ever since I joined," he recounted. Though groups changed over time, the Y's community spirit provided continuity. "Since then, I have been welcomed into a new group."

Their routine – workouts followed by conversation – strengthens bonds. Something such as a spontaneous swim invitation underscores their connection. "It's more fun when you have someone to workout with," he emphasized. "They offer encouragement and share things about their daily life. I'm with somebody every day Monday-Friday." His commitment is clear: "If it weren't for the friendships I have made here, I would not come every day." It's clear that these connections bring a joy to his routine that a solitary workout simply couldn't match. The welcoming attitude to new members further exemplifies the Y's community spirit.
