PLEASE NOTE:

- Members must be 18+ years old to bring a guest.
- Ages 12 & under not allowed to sit on the fitness floor/group ex classes while parents/guardian participates.
- For safety reasons, members ages 13-14 can not reenter the building once they have left without an adult check-in.
 Once signed in, members 13-14 may be in the facility for a maximum of 2 hours without adult supervision.
- Direct adult supervision means maintaining consistent direct line of sight and must be able to get to child within 30 seconds in case of an emergency.
